Get to know your AT&T Cruise package

A cruise package covers you:

• While cruising onboard a qualifying cruise ship, your device will connect to the cruise ship's cellular network, and the network name "Cellular at Sea," "Nor-18", or "901-18" will appear in the upper left corner.

A cruise package doesn't cover you:

- On a non-qualifying cruise ship.
- In port or on land.

Stay connected in port or on land, in over 210+ destinations

• With AT&T International Day Pass, you can talk, text and use your wireless plan data in over 210 destinations for \$10/day for your first line. You never pay for more than 10 days per line, per bill, and each additional line is \$5/day if used on the same calendar day. Plus, only pay for the days you use.

Coverage not available in all areas. **Terms and data allowance from your domestic plan, fees and other restrictions apply and are subject to change.** If you talk, send a text or use data in any of the included countries, you'll be charged \$10 per 24 hours and \$5 for each add'l line on the same account used the same calendar day unless you remove AT&T Int'l Day Pass. **Charge cap:** A max. of 10 daily fees per line, per monthly bill cycle. Cruise travel tips

The following tips will help you manage your costs and make the most of your AT&T Cruise package:

■ Manage your apps

Some apps consume more data than others. Knowing this in advance of your travels can help you avoid unexpected charges. Consider monitoring usage of:

- Apps that use location like navigation, news and weather
- Social media
- Video chatting
- Games with heavy graphics and those requiring an internet connection

Disable unused apps

Disable any apps running in the background that you are not using.

For iOS devices: Go to Settings>General> Background. Turn Background App Refresh to OFF or Wi-Fi only.

For Android devices: Go to Settings>Connections> Data Usage. Turn Data Saver ON and select only the apps you want to allow to use data in the background.

Avoid streaming

Streaming content is extremely data intensive. You can download content before leaving the U.S. to avoid streaming movies, videos, music or other content while abroad.



Track your usage

You can track your cellular data usage with your device's auto-check feature. Reset the tracker once you reach your international destination.

For iOS devices: Go to Settings>Cellular. Scroll to bottom and click on Reset Statistics. Locate Wi-Fi Assist. You may want to turn Wi-Fi Assist OFF to avoid using cellular when you intend to use Wi-Fi.

For Android devices: Data usage is tracked by bill cycle, so make note of how much data has been used when you arrive. Or you can download a data usage app from Google Play.

How to add an AT&T Cruise Package to your account:

- Login to your MyATT account and add it to your line of service under Manage add-ons

Disable email auto-check

Switch your phone's email settings from Push to Fetch. This allows you to manually download your email when connected to Wi-Fi.

Avoid sending or receiving large email files like pictures or videos when on the cellular network.

For iOS devices: Go to Settings>Accounts & Passwords>Fetch New Data. Turn Push to OFF and under Fetch below, select MANUALLY.

For Android devices: Turn Data Saver ON and make sure email is not selected to allow data usage in the background.



Use Wi-Fi connections when available

Wi-Fi usage does not count toward your data allowance. Check with your cruise line for details on available Wi-Fi options aboard ship. Using the ship's Wi-Fi services will minimize usage of the cellular network. Wi-Fi charges may be incurred directly by the cruise ship or network provider.



Data usage with iMessage

When you're traveling abroad, iMessage (and other calling and messaging apps) are treated as data rather than as text messages. Use of iMessage is billed as cellular data usage. To disable iMessage, go to Messages in the Settings menu.



Turn off data roaming

When you don't want to use cellular data, turn it off entirely. Go to Settings on your device and look for Cellular or Network options.

AT&T Cruise packages: Eligibility: Compatible device with eligible domestic postpaid wireless service required. Charges: One-time charge of \$60 per line for Cruise Basic package or \$100 per line for Cruise Plus package is valid for 30 days beginning on the chosen effective date, may cross 2 bill cycles, and expires automatically. Package charge will not be prorated if canceled on or after the effective date. If package is canceled prior to the effective date, the line will not be charged. Coverage: Package applies to cellular use onboard select cruise ships listed at att.com/cruise when salling in international waters. When the device is connected to the ship's cellular network, "cellularatese", "901-18" on the device. The ship turns off its cellular network when it is within 12 nautical miles from land and docked or tendered in port, at which point cellular service is provided via the nearest country. Countries: Add AT&T International Day Pass to your eligible domestic wireless plan to cover your usage when on land or in port. Go to att.com/internationalforbiz to review options. Data: For smartphones and tablets only. Includes 100MB of data for Cruise Basic package or 1GB of data for Cruise Plus package. Actual data speeds vary by device and ship. Data use is subject to the same network management practices as your domestic wireless plan. See att.com/broadbandinfo for details. Data overage: If you exceed the amount of data in your Cruise package, additional data will automatically be provided in increments of 100MB for \$10 each. Once you have incurred \$100 in data overage charges or, for business and government customers, \$300 in data overage charges, data use is subject to suspension, including data use on land, even if you have a separate international package for data usage on land. Upon suspension, AT&T will provide notice and instructions for restoring data use capability. Talk: For phones only. Applies to all cellular calls dialed and accepted. Cruise Basic package includes 100 minutes of calling. With W
